## APPLICATION

**Thermonett® Protector** is intended to be used in a closed circuit.

Introduce the product using a proportioning pump to a level of 1% of the volume of water in circulation, then leave the product in the installation.

The concentration of **Thermonett® Protector** can then be controlled once per annum using the **Concentration Test**.

For a better protection, Climalife recommends a preliminary cleaning with **Thermonett® Sludge Remover**.

**Thermonett® Protector** is compatible with all type of materials, including components containing aluminium or synthetic material.
